

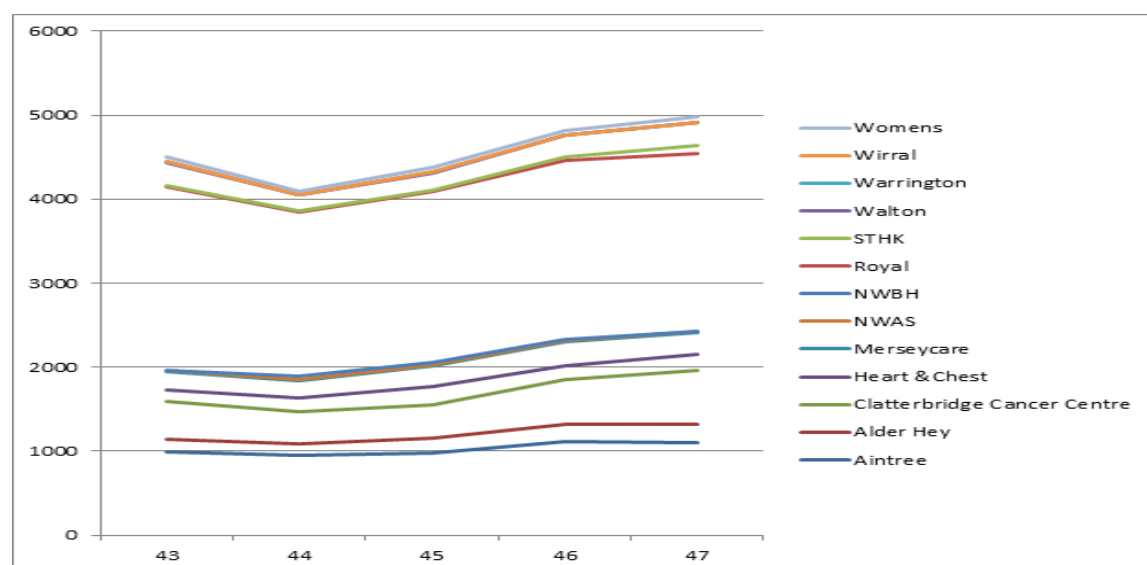
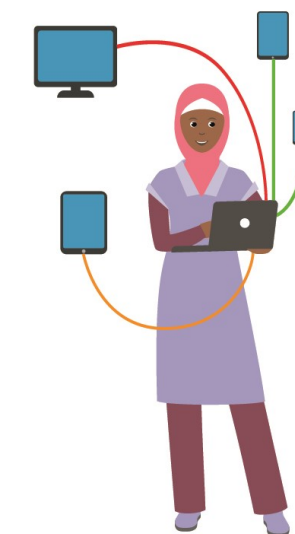

10 week Sprint So Far...

A 10 week sprint has been underway in the S2C programme since 26/10/20, which has received great response from organisations across the region.

Achievements to date so far:

- ◆ Warrington have now commenced testing of the integrated desktop icon. Ophthalmology is now publishing into the shared record.
- ◆ A number of video blogs and quote cards have been created by clinicians. These are being shared via Twitter as part of the communication and engagement plan.
- ◆ Liverpool Women's are now publishing Gynaecology ED discharge summaries. K2 Maternity is now in test and will be available in the next few weeks.
- ◆ North West Boroughs have access to view into the shared record.
- ◆ Mersey Care are now technically able to publish documents.
- ◆ St Helens have a dedicated lead to complete the work required to enable clinic letters to be published.
- ◆ All GP practices in Cheshire and Merseyside are to have access to e-Xchange as a pilot. This was the outcome of a meeting to discuss safe certification of deaths in the community and how e-Xchange can support this.
- ◆ Following on from the clinical engagement month. We are continuing with our engagement plan throughout the 10 week sprint. We have had a fantastic grand round with The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre, which has led to a roll out of clinical meetings with acute oncology teams across the region.
- ◆ Utilisation of e-Xchange continues to grow with an 11% increase in usage during November (see graph below).
